RULES & CODE OF CONDUCT

It is the intent of the Mansfield YMCA to provide a safe and friendly environment for all members, volunteers, and staff. We strive to have our members and staff exemplify an attitude of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. Please join us as we strive to strengthen the foundations of this community by supporting youth development, promoting healthy living and committing to our social responsibility.

- ❖ Please present your membership card up entry to the facility.
- ❖ All persons using the facility or grounds are expected to follow all YMCA policies and procedures and to conduct themselves appropriately. Physical or verbal abuse, sexual innuendo or display, or offensive behavior of any kind is unacceptable and will not be tolerated.
- ❖ It is illegal to carry a firearm, deadly weapon, or dangerous ordnance anywhere on YMCA property.
- ❖ The YMCA is a smoke, drug and alcohol free facility. This also includes its grounds. The possession or sale of any drugs or drug paraphernalia will lead to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law.
- ❖ Children ages 9 and under are to be supervised at all times by a parent or responsible adult (16 years or older), unless participating in a staff supervised program.
- ❖ Persons responsible for any loss or damage to YMCA or that of its members, volunteers or staff will be held personally and financially liable.
- ❖ Please wear proper gym, swim and workout attire. No jeans, cut-off shirts or shirts that show midriff are allowed in the Wellness area. No cotton material is allowed to be worn in the pool or spa.
- ❖ Please store your personal belongings in a locked locker (bring your own lock). We also rent lockers for \$6/month. The YMCA is not responsible for any items stolen from facility grounds.
- ❖ Please do not leave your locks on the lockers in the locker rooms. Items must be removed daily.
- ❖ YMCA staff has the right to determine if any conduct or language is inconsistent with the mission of the YMCA and to act accordingly.
- ❖ Failure to follow the above Rules & Code of Conduct will be considered in violation of the "Member Behavior Code" and may result in permanent or temporary suspension of membership privileges.
- ❖ The protection of members, volunteers and guests who are participating in programs or are using YMCA facilities is the paramount concern to the Board & Staff of the Mansfield YMCA. The YMCA regularly reviews sex offender registries and denies access and/or membership to any person the YMCA learns is a registered sex offender.
